**Kindergarten Registration**

Sacred Heart School is holding both all school tuition registration and Kindergarten registration for the 2018-19 school year on Thursday, May 10 and Friday, May 11 from 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Kindergarten parents begin tuition registration at the Parish office and proceed to the school office for registration.

Kindergarten parents should provide the following by the first day of school:

1. Proof of a health examination.
2. Proof of a dental examination or a signed waiver.
3. Proof of an eye examination by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver.
4. Proof of a lead screening.
5. Proof of immunizations against preventable, communicable diseases.
6. Proof of a 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella injection.
7. Copy of birth certificate. (Certified copy from the courthouse.)
