Making connections. We step away from reading the Gospel of Mark today to hear the ending scene from Matthew. It makes the connection to Matthew 25 heard last November on Christ the King. The scene, then, was the great divide of sheep and goats – the naming of the Works of Mercy. The scene today is both the ending of Jesus’ earthly ministry and the beginning of the Church’s. This ministry is (1) to go to all nations and peoples; (2) to baptize; (3) to train and form new followers, new disciples. They were told then as we are assured today: Jesus is present with us always – along with Father and Spirit.

- Where and when do I see the presence of God in the world?
- Where and when do I feel the saving presence of Christ?
- Where and when do I know the Spirit is taking control?
