Sacred Heart School is holding both all school tuition registration and Kindergarten registration for the 2018-19 school year on Thursday, May 10 and Friday, May 11 from 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Kindergarten parents begin tuition registration at the Parish office and proceed to the school office for registration.

Kindergarten parents should provide the following by the first day of school:

1. Proof of a health examination.
2. Proof of a dental examination or a signed waiver.
3. Proof of an eye examination by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver.
4. Proof of a lead screening.
5. Proof of immunizations against preventable, communicable diseases.
6. Proof of a 2nd Varicella injection.
7. Copy of birth certificate. (Certified copy from the courthouse.)

Physical, dental, and eye exam forms available at this time, if needed. School registration forms available at www.shspana.com under the information tab. Please fill out and bring the day of registration.
