#### **REMINDERS:**

**IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED WITH CHRISY FOR TUITION, PLEASE DO SO BEFORE OUR SCHOOL REGISTRATION. WE CANNOT REGISTER YOU FOR SCHOOL UNTIL THIS IS DONE.**

Please remember that it is mandatory for Kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders to have a dental exam or you must sign a waiver. Any Kindergarten student should also have an eye exam by a licensed optometrist or you must sign a waiver and a 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella vaccine. Any student entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade should have proof of having a T-Dap vaccine, 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella injection, and a meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV). Also, any student entering Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> grade, or anyone playing 7-8th grade sports should have a physical exam.
