REMINDERS:

IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED WITH CHRISY FOR TUITION, PLEASE DO SO BEFORE OUR SCHOOL REGISTRATION. WE CANNOT REGISTER YOU FOR SCHOOL UNTIL THIS IS DONE.

Please remember that it is mandatory for Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th graders to have a dental exam or you must sign a waiver. Any Kindergarten student should also have an eye exam by a licensed optometrist or you must sign a waiver and a 2nd Varicella vaccine. Any student entering 6th grade should have proof of having a T-Dap vaccine, 2nd Varicella injection, and a meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV). Also, any student entering Kindergarten, 6th grade, or anyone playing 7-8th grade sports should have a physical exam.
