**CHILDREN’S LITURGY OF THE WORD
CHANGE OF DATE**

Beginning September 16, St. Pat’s will offer a Children’s Liturgy of the Word at 10:30 am Mass to help children hear God’s message in a way that is more understandable for them. All children, preferably 4 years old -3rd grade, including visitors, are welcome. Parents or older siblings may accompany a child. Prior to the first reading, Fr. Rodney will invite children up front for a short prayer of blessing and present them with their Lectionary. They will proceed to the Sacristy for the Sunday readings, have conversation and prayer centered on the message, and pray their own General Intercessions. Afterwards, they will be escorted back into church, invited to place their own envelopes in the collection basket, and rejoin their families. Please remember this is not a religion “lesson”, but a time for prayer and hearing the Word of God.
