1. Proof of having a health examination.
2. Proof of having a dental examination or a signed waiver.
3. Proof of having an eye examination by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver.
4. Proof of having a lead screening.
5. Proof of having received immunizations against preventable communicable diseases.
6. Proof of having 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella injection.
7. Copy of birth certificate. (Must be a certified copy from the court house)
