PENALTY: For <u>ALL EVENTS</u> that require ticket sales – a penalty of \$5 per ticket per day will be applied for any tickets turned in past the due date. For any event assigned but was not worked, there is a \$400 penalty.

EVENT DETAILS:

Shamrock Sweeps:

Requirement: 30 tickets sold

\$40,000 Grand Prize with maximum of 2,500 tickets sold (5) \$400 prize daily drawings 3/11/24-3/15/24

All families are required to either sell or purchase a total of <u>thirty</u> \$50 tickets to the "Shamrock Sweeps" Raffle. A signature will be required when picking up the tickets. Additional tickets will be available to sell with signature and payment up front.

Dates:

15 tickets due on or before August 2, 2023 15 tickets due on or before February 15, 2024

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If a family does not receive their Shamrock tickets until Registration in August, then their first 15 tickets will be due on Tuesday, September 5, 2023.


Tickets must be turned into the school or church office in a *sealed envelope* marked "Shamrock Sweeps" along with name of family.

Drawing Dates:

**NOTES: Multiple purchasers of one ticket will be allowed. Each ticket will be eligible for ALL drawings even if the ticket is a previous winner. Each family is responsible for purchasing lost or misplaced tickets. If all money and tickets are not turned in by February 15, 2024, your child will not receive their 3rd quarter and 4th quarter report card (\$5 per day penalty also applies).



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Auction:

Requirement: \$20 per child at Registration

*See Parent Assignments A \$20 donation is required for one child (or \$40 for 2+ children) to help pay for class baskets that will be auctioned off.

Music Bingo:

Requirement: 4 tickets sold or purchased *See Parent Assignments

Each family must sell or purchase 4 tickets valued at \$20/ticket.

Angelo's Dinner:

Requirement: 15 tickets sold

*See Parent Assignments Each family must sell or purchase 15 tickets valued at \$13/ticket. (*ticket prices may increase if the cost of food increases.)

<u>Calendar</u>:

Requirement: Each date sold

*See Parent Assignments

Each family is required to sell or purchase all calendar days for the month of April. Each day costs their date. Example – April 1 is \$1, April 15 is \$15. Total value of calendar is \$465. Calendar and total of \$465 must be turned by May 1. Drawing details to be announced later.



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PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

This *tentative* schedule for the Tuition Reimbursement Program is given out by the School Board as a consideration of each family's time and schedule. All dates, number of tickets required, and events are subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances.

Parent Assignments:

The Parent Assignment schedule for the Tuition Reimbursement Program events will be handed out in May. If you are assigned to an event, you are required to serve on the committee and also work the day of the actual event. Please note - these assignments are also subject to change. Any families registering after May will be added to these assignments.

These assignments will take in to consideration families who already volunteer their time at Sacred Heart School.

Any changes to the events, dates or parent assignments will be communicated via Fast Direct. Please make sure you are signed up for an account and check it often.

Parent participation, advertisement and general support is imperative to the success of the Tuition Reimbursement Program events. If you are not scheduled to work an event, please do your part by participating in the event and advertising to the public.

NOTE: The Sacred Heart School Board is responsible for developing and maintaining a sound financial plan for SHS. Updates on the progress towards our financial goals are posted on <u>www.shspana.com</u> at least quarterly so that parents can be kept up to date on progress.
