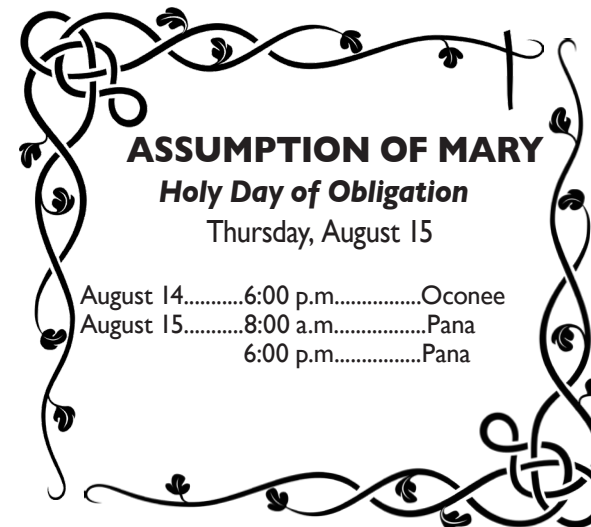

REMINDERS:

TUITION PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED WITH CHRISY BEFORE SCHOOL REGISTRATION IS ALLOWED.

It is mandatory for Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th graders to have a dental exam or a signed waiver. Kindergarten students should have an eye exam by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver and a 2nd Varicella vaccine. Students entering 6th grade should have proof of having a T-Dap vaccine, 2nd Varicella injection, and a meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV). Students entering Kindergarten, 6th grade, or anyone playing 7-8th grade sports should have a physical exam. Please mark your calendars, as this date and time are very important. RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

From Fr. Joseph...If I could ask a few favors...

- 1) If you receive on the tongue, please fully open your mouth; fully extend your tongue; and don't close your mouth until my fingers are away from your mouth. This should be self-explanatory.
- 2) If you receive in the hand, please place your left hand under your right hand; use your right hand to place the Sacred Host in your mouth; and don't pull back until the Sacred Host has been placed on you hand. Please do not "pluck" the Sacred Host; wait to receive it.
- 3) If you receive in the hand, please step up close enough. I do not have long arms. (Neither do some of our other Communion Ministers).
- 4) Please speak audibly with your "Amen" after the words, "The Body of Christ" have been spoken to you.
