




# SACRED HEART SCHOOL TUITION REGISTRATION AND KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

Sacred Heart School will be holding both all school tuition registration and Kindergarten registration on the same dates and times - Thursday, May 9th and Friday, May 10th from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. All Kindergarten parents must go to the Parish office first for tuition registration and then go to the school office for Kindergarten registration. Book fee and Chrisy's tuition registration papers can be left in the black, locked mailbox outside the Parish Office: however, you still need to see Teresa at the School Office.

Kindergarten parents should provide the following by the first day of school:

- I. Proof of having a health examination.
- 2. Proof of having a dental examination or a signed waiver.
- 3. Proof of having an eye examination by a licensed optometrist or a signed waiver.
- 4. Proof of having a lead screening.
- 5. Proof of having received immunizations against preventable communicable diseases.
- 6 Proof of having 2nd Varicella injection.
- 7. Copy of birth certificate. (Must be a certified copy from the court house)

Parents will receive physical, dental, and eye exam forms at this time, if needed. They are also available at <a href="https://www.shspana.com/registration">www.shspana.com/registration</a>.
