



Sacred Heart School PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES



Sacred Heart School License Plates are being sold for the 2024-25 SHS winter sports season. Plates will be eligible for display from <u>December 31, 2024 until February 28, 2025</u>. Cost is \$40 per set. Personalization is available and consists of a <u>maximum of 4 characters (with 1 space if desired)</u>. Letters will precede numbers and there must be a space between letters and numbers. (Examples: SHS 4, MOM 5, CRUZ, 1988, DEB Z, FAN 1). Feel free to get creative!

Orders for <u>personalized plates</u> must be received no later than <u>July 31, 2024</u> and cannot be accepted after this date. Since school is not in session, <u>Payment will be due at time of delivery</u> (sometime in <u>December</u>). No changes or corrections can be made after personalized orders are submitted to SOS. Be sure you have the correct spelling and numbers <u>before</u> you place your order!!!

In the event of a duplicate request, preference will be given on a first-come, first-served basis. We will only be ordering 50 sets of plates, so a limited quantity of numbered plates may be available for general purchase in December.

Please complete a separate form for each set of plates requested. Return completed forms to Sheila Siegert via the following options: Fast Direct, email at ssiegert@shspana.org, the Parish Office by hand delivery or at St Patrick's Church P.O. Box 440 Pana IL 62557. You may also drop orders in the collection basket at weekend Masses. Please contact Sheila by email or text (217-825-8264) with questions. You must provide a photocopy or text a picture of the entire vehicle registration form to Sheila prior to receiving the plates in December. The registration must be current through February 28, 2025. If your registration expires between December 2024 and February 2025, it must be renewed and proof of renewal provided to Sheila prior to receiving the plates. This is a Secretary of State requirement.

The following Illinois Secretary of State guidelines must be met for special event plates: Plates may be displayed on passenger vehicles and B-trucks. The vehicle must be currently registered in Illinois. Registrations that expire December 2024 through February 2025 must be renewed before special event plates can be issued. All registration information will be verified by the Secretary of State and your order will be nullified if incomplete or incorrect information is provided.
